HEARING ASSISTANCE



Meet Our Ministry Intern, Heather Dechent



Open & Affirming Updates

John 15:12 says, "my command is this: love each other as I have loved you." Keeping this teaching in mind, we would like to remind you that our church has organized a working group of volunteers to provide informational opportunities about the possibility of advancing our status as an Open and Affirming church. The current members of the group are Pastor Katrina Manzi, Sal Sena, Val and Len Beard, Debbie Barlow, and myself: Kelly Ecsedy.

The purpose of these informational opportunities will be to answer questions or address concerns that members of our church may have about the possibility of moving forward as an Open and Affirming congregation.

On October 15, we will offer a viewing of the movie "Pray Away" in the social hall. This is a documentary that is available on Netflix for those would like to view it in advance. On October 19th, there will be a discussion of this movie, also in the social hall, for those who wish to participate in person or virtually.

This winter, there will be a book discussion (book and date TBD) so keep a look out for further details on this. We are also currently finalizing plans to invite a guest preacher to speak about LGBTQ+ as well as provide some questions and answers related to some LGBTQ+ issues in the church.
