THE OFFICE OF TENEBRAE

Office, when used in this context, refers to the practice of praying at fixed hours of the day or night. Tenebrae is a Latin word meaning shadows or darkness. This liturgy, which has roots in the 7th Century, is characterized by the gradual extinguishing of lights. It is intended to remind the worshiper of Jesus' abandonment by his disciples and his eventual crucifixion and burial. At the end of the Service, the church will be in darkness. Please remain seated until the final choir anthem is finished and then depart in silence.
